PROCEDURES TO BE FOLLOWED FOR SEAFARER TRAINING AND CERTIFICATION FOR EMERGENCY, OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY, SECURITY, MEDICAL CARE AND SURVIVAL FUNCTIONS.

1. INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this circular is to outline the procedure that the Shipowner/Managers and Recognised Organisation should follow if requesting any of the following:

- i. Certificates and Endorsements, Regulation I/2,
- ii. Training record.

2. PROCEDURE

Certificates and Endorsements, Regulation I/2:

All Basic Training certificates issued by training facilities thus accredited by MPABD are required to be endorse before the expiry date of the certificates.

- Personal Survival Techniques (STCW Code – Table A-VI/1-1).
- Fire Prevention and Fire Fighting (STCW Code – Table A-VI/1-2).
- Elementary First Aid (STCW Code – Table A-VI/1-3).
- Personal Safety and Social Responsibilities (STCW Code - Table AVI/1-4).

Certificate to be Endorse shall be valid and submitted by the Shipowner/Seafarers to Maritime Training Standards section, MPABD.

Seafarers qualified in BASIC training shall require, every 5 years, to provide evidence of having maintained the required standard of competence, to undertake the task, duties and responsibilities on board.

Training record

The STCW permits some elements of the updating training to be carried out onboard ship, with the exception of Fire Prevention and Fire Fighting (FP & FF). This can be achieved by the seafarer completing and signing a self-declaration form. (Please refer to attached form).

Request for an extension of the certificates, to provide evidence of having maintained the required standard of competence, to undertake the task, duties and responsibilities listed in STCW code tables A-VI/1-1 and A-VI/1-2.

Submit application form to Maritime Training and Standards section in MPABD (as per attached form).

3. MPABD APPROVAL

MPABD will notify the company/applicant of the decision and will issue the certificate.
